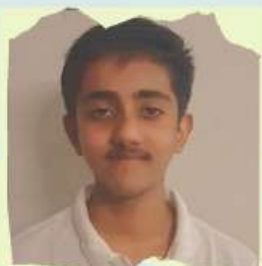

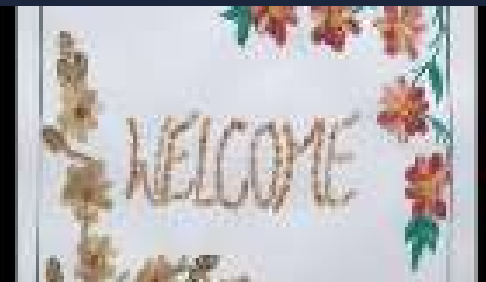

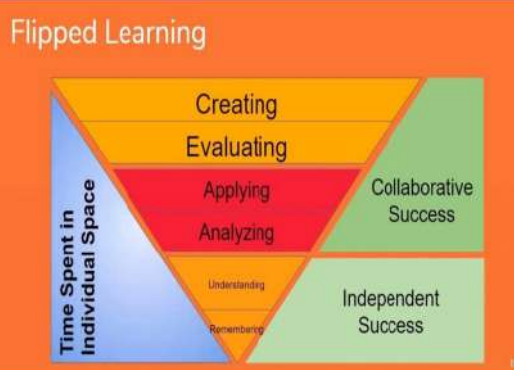

Following were the tips given by the speaker on how to maintain a healthier lifestyle and to prepare you to cope with the stress of everyday living.

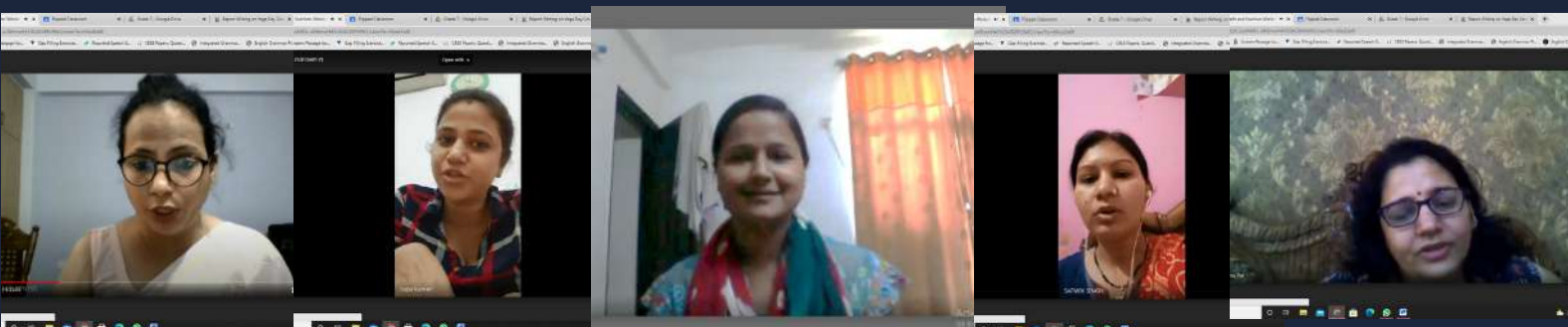
- Structure each day to include a minimum of 20 minutes of aerobic exercise.

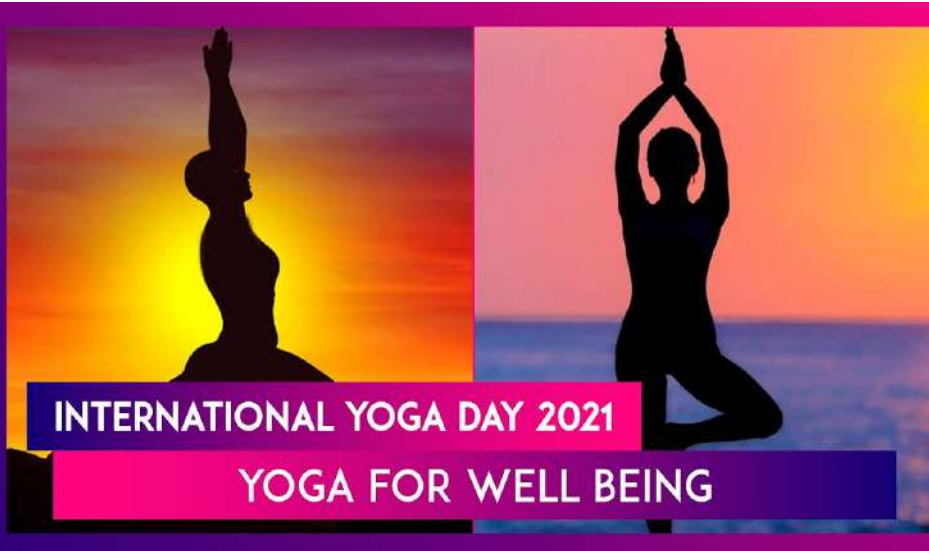
A healthy mind lives in a healthy body.

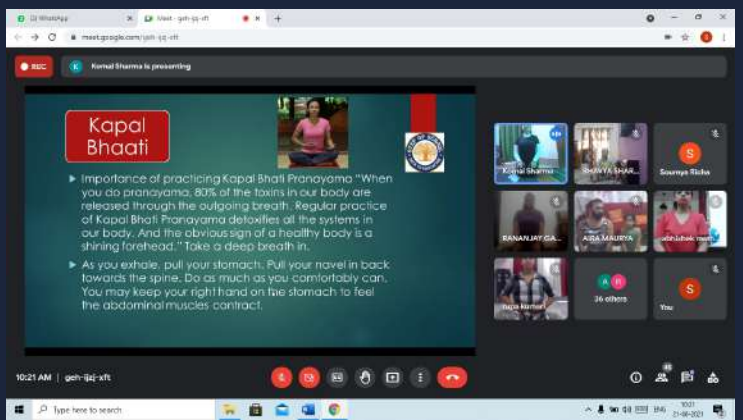
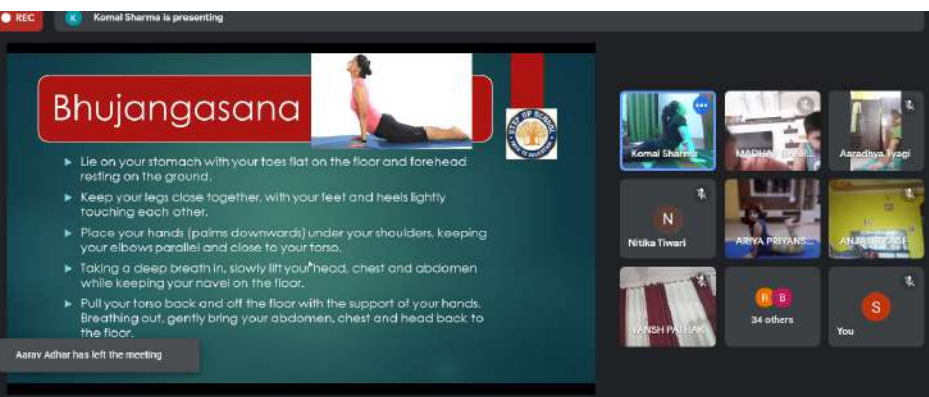


INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

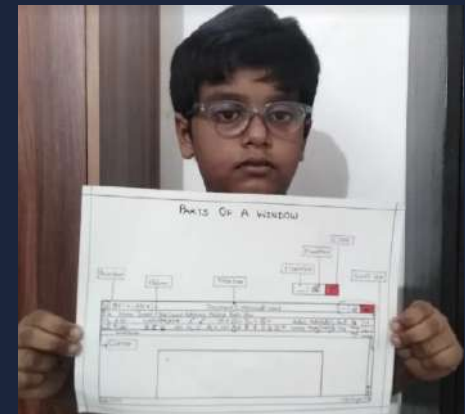
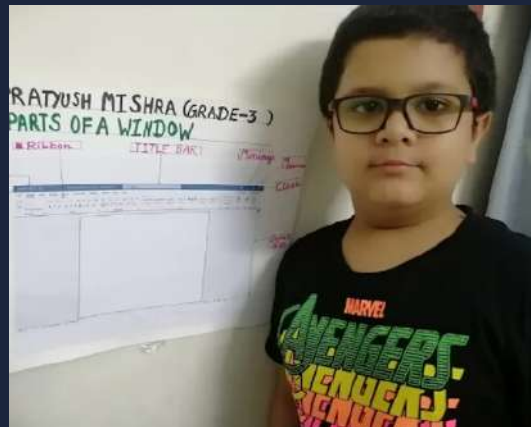
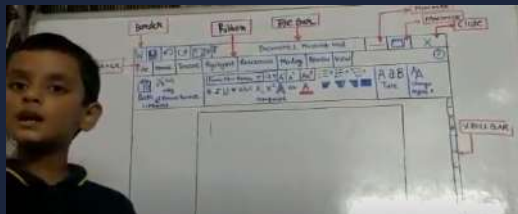

FATHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

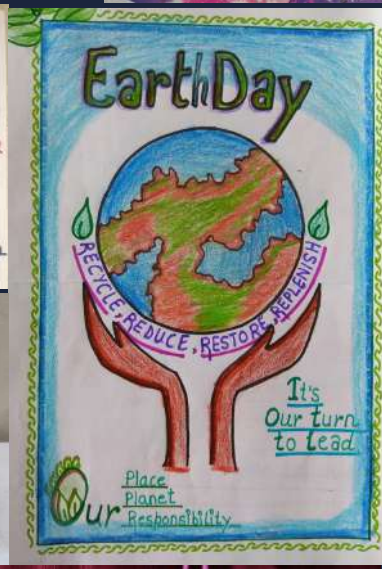

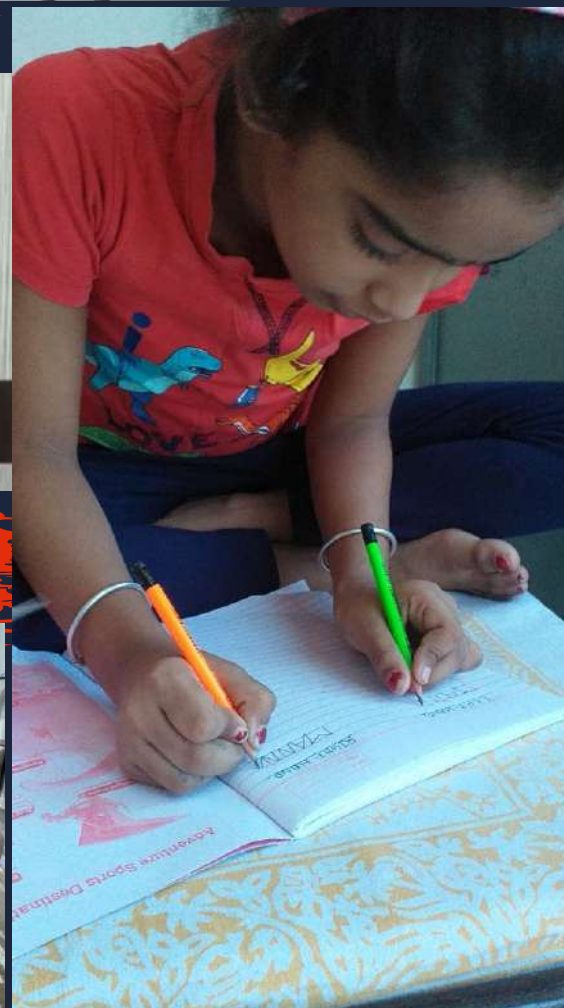
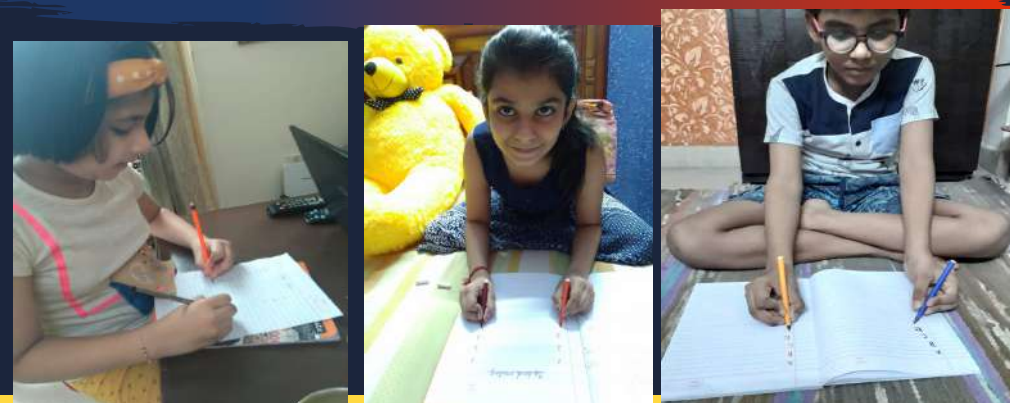
In Brain Teaser classes we also teach them positive thinking as it leads to enhanced creativity, staying focused, problem-solving skills, and overall mental productivity.

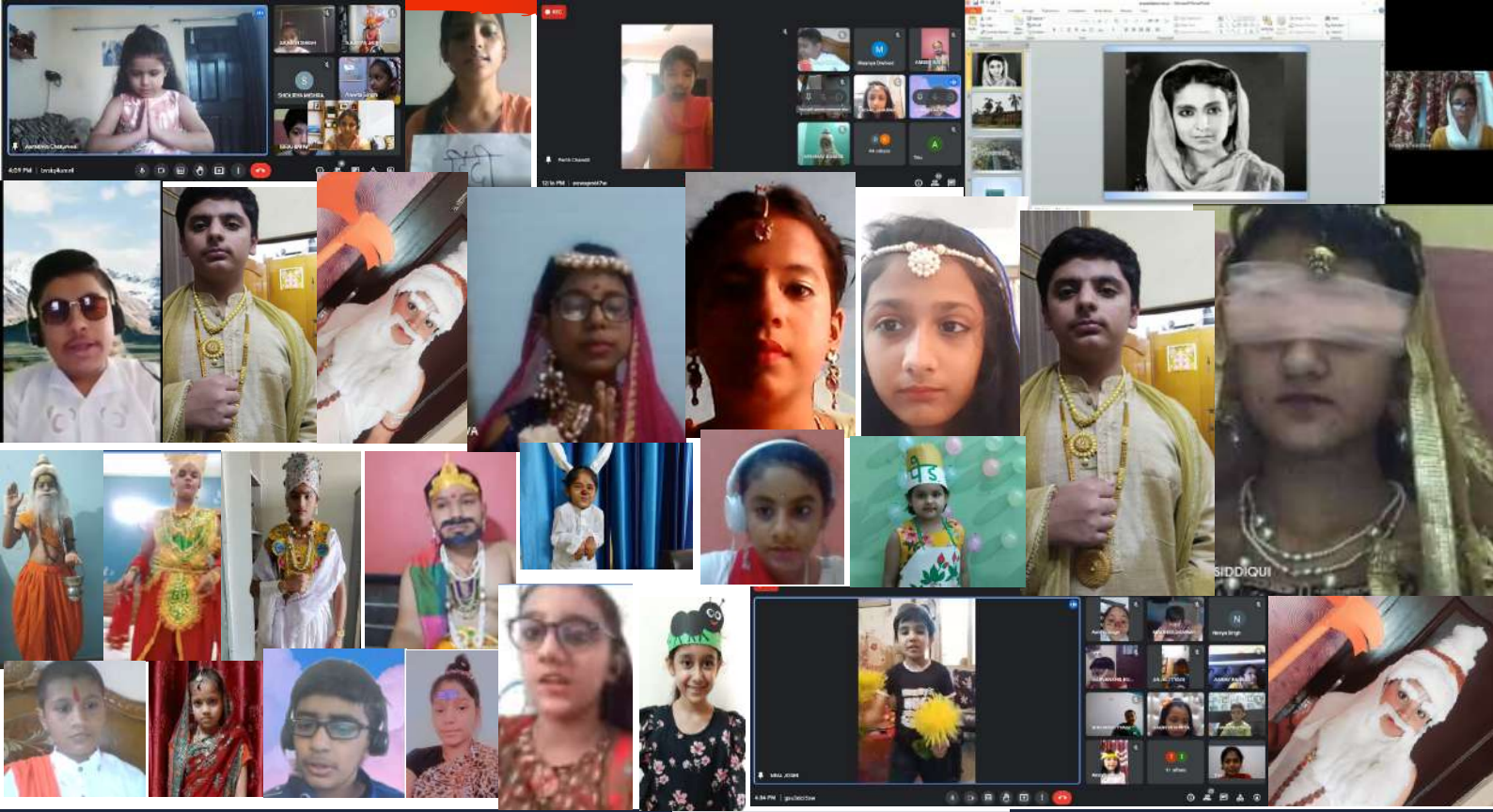
THE MATHEMATICS CARNIVAL: A PLATFORM TO APPRECIATE MATHEMATICS

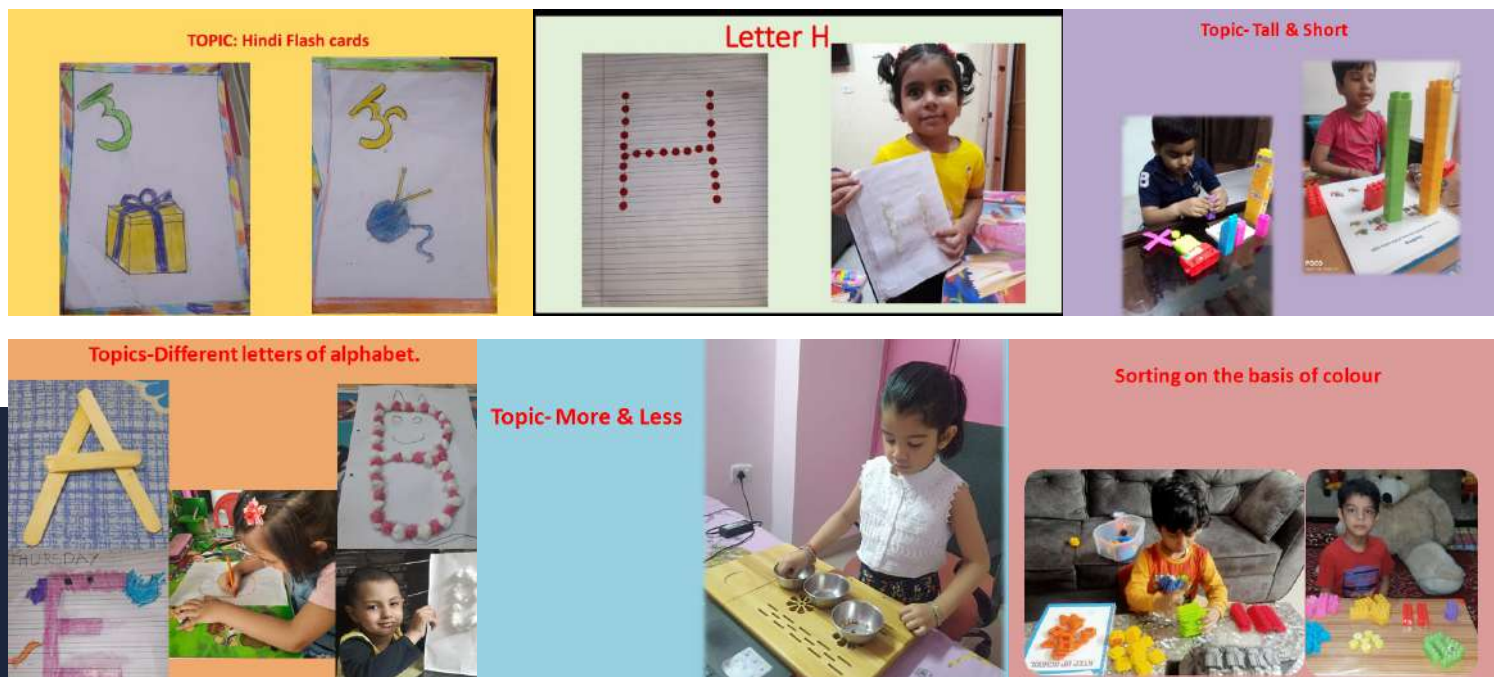


ACTIVITY BASED LEARNING (PRE-PRIMARY) SESSION-2021-2022

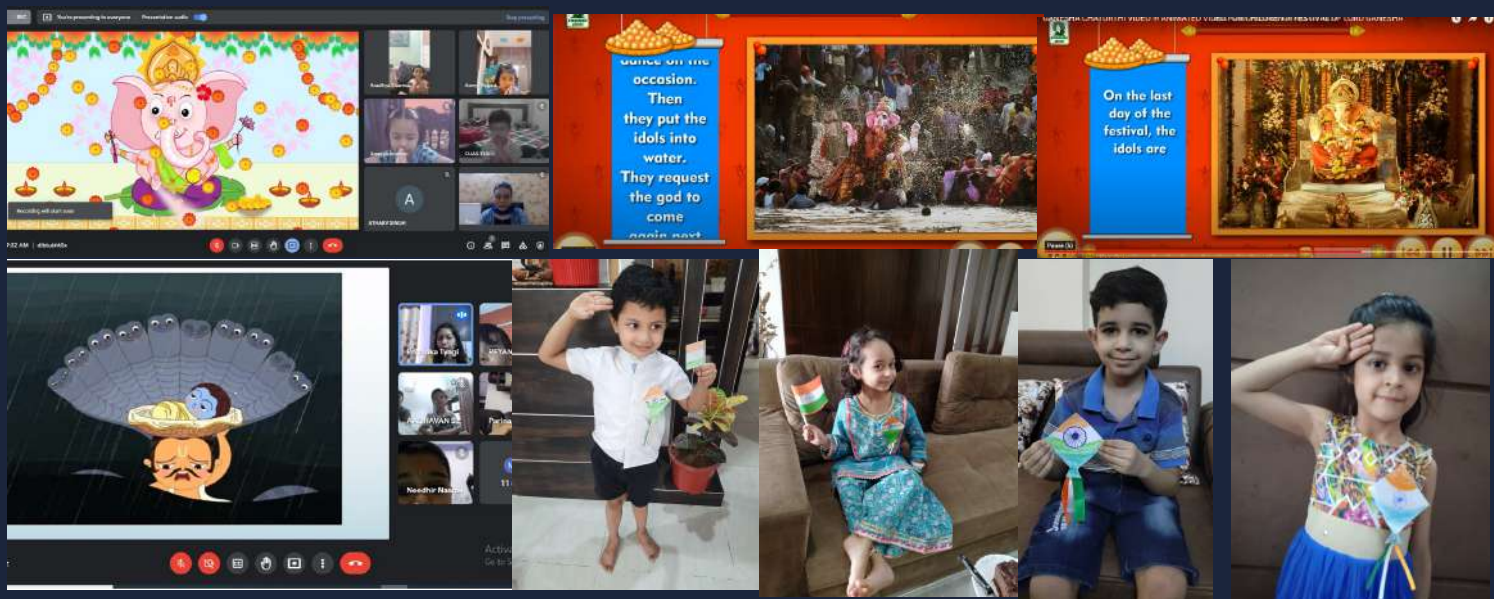

Story Telling (Pre-primary)

SESSION-2021-2022

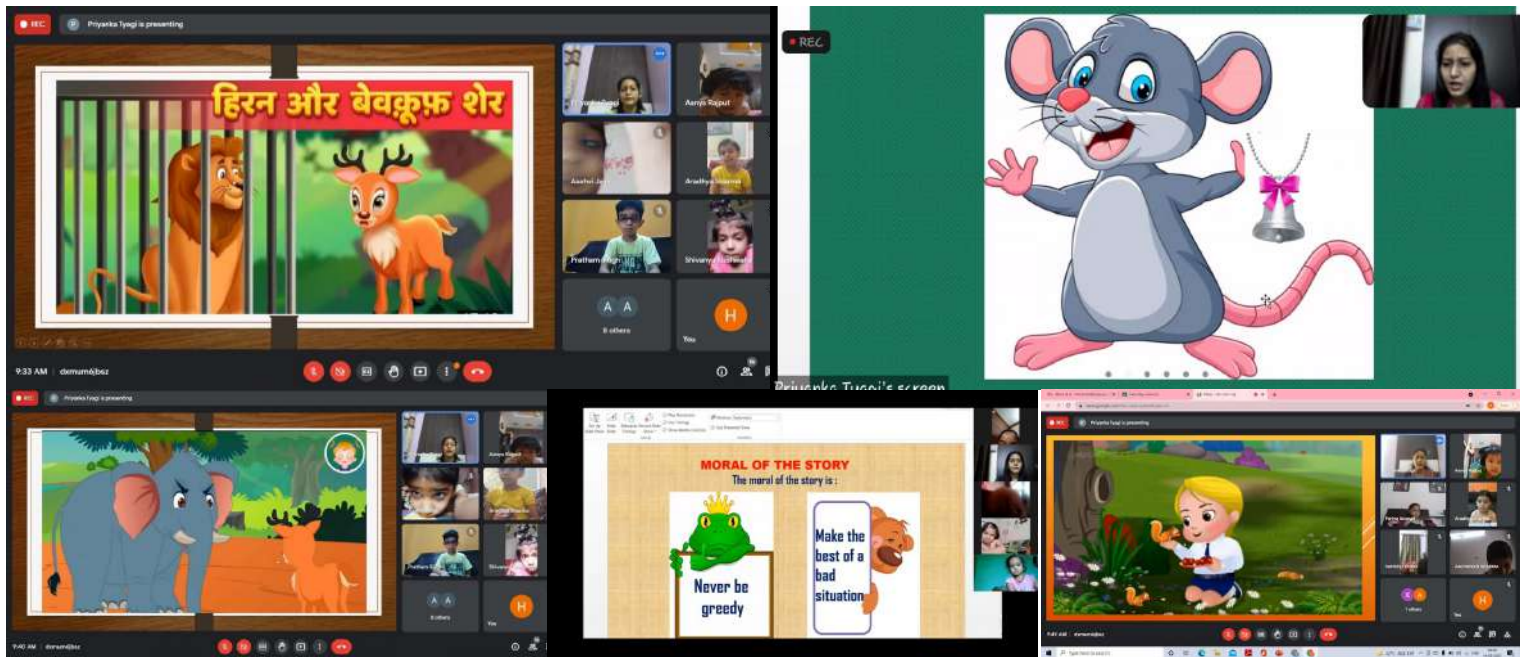


Stories create magic and a sense of wonder at the world. Storytelling is a unique way for kids to develop an understanding, respect and appreciation for other cultures, and can promote a positive attitude to people from different lands and religions. In schools where improving basic literacy levels is a priority, storytelling can be used to quickly raise standards while developing skills, knowledge and confidence in a range of other areas.

Another advantage of listening to stories is that children grow in academic learning. Story telling introduces lot of new vocabulary to children. At homes, people communicate with limited number of words. But stories will have academic level vocabulary and lot of newer words for the kids to learn. It is easy to teach the meanings of the words as kids learn faster from the context of the story.

At Step Up, we take story telling sessions on alternate Saturdays. The stories are chosen very carefully keeping in mind the moral value that a child will receive from it. We take one English and one Hindi story alternatively. Teachers prepare Props/puppets/ppts, to make story telling session more interesting.

BRAIN TEASER (PREPRIMARY) SESSION-2021-2022

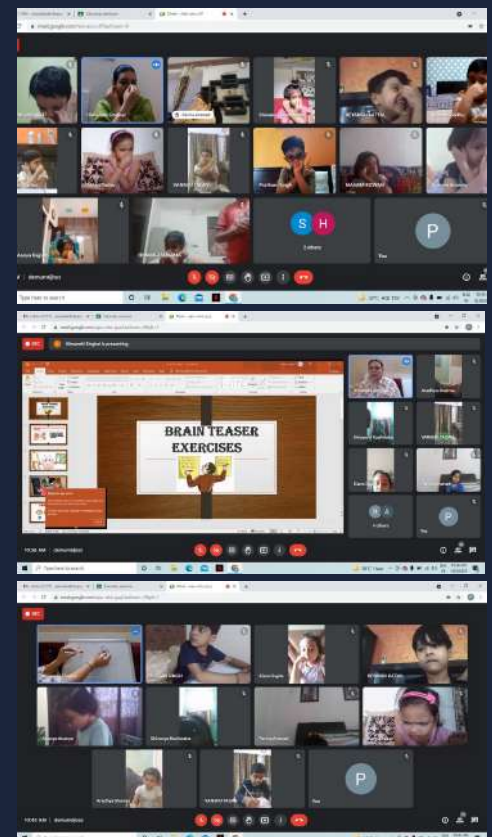


Brain Teaser Activities are planned for the students of Preprimary wing on alternate Saturdays. These activities are taken, keeping in mind, the benefits they provide to our tiny tots.

Brain teasers help stimulate a child's cognitive abilities, as well as assisting them to improve sitting still and staying focused on one task.

Brain teasers and puzzles, exercise the mind in a different way to conventional learning. Like any other muscle, we need to keep our brain in shape and keep up our mental strength, and starting from an early age helps. Maintaining an exercised mind can help with children's school work, physical activities and the ability to adapt to new things much quicker. It also sharpens their thinking skills and help them to concentrate or stay focused on one task.

We indulge our students in different brain exercises and brain games like, memory game, match the shadow, puzzles etc to enhance their creativity and strengthen their memory.



VIRTUAL TOUR (PRE-PRIMARY) SESSION-2021-2022

Education and learning processes should not only be limited to the classroom. The real-world connection and hands-on experience are proven methods for better understanding or learning. Theoretical knowledge in the books is not always enough to furnish the essential information to the students. The retention of a concept is better when the student experiences it practically. Field trips act as a significant help in this area.

Covid-19 has created an unprecedented situation. As a result, education has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms. We, at Step Up School always thrive to give our best to our students and work hard so that the current situation does not become a barrier in the teaching-learning process. Thus, we started virtual Sessions on Educational tours and excursions.

At Step Up, we take Virtual Tour sessions on alternate Saturdays using PowerPoint presentations and videos. The places for tour/excursion are chosen very carefully keeping in mind the level of our students and the knowledge they will gain from it. For Example- Virtual tour to Red Fort was taken in mid-August to tell our students more about Independence Day.
